Warm Christian greetings from South Africa! As mentioned in previous letters, our students come from several different countries throughout Africa. Let me introduce you to a couple of them.

Haille is from Ethiopia. He is the quiet one. If you don't see him, you won't know he is there. I recently learned that before he really met the Master he had spent 13 years in an Ethiopian Coptic Church monastery. One of the disciplines of this monastery was an emphasis on "quietness". He was doing it as a religious duty hoping to get recognition from God. That recognition was shown redemptively in Jesus Christ. Haille received the message of salvation, walked out of the monastery and began to follow Jesus. He has made remarkable progress while here, academically, spiritually and even conversationally, but is still a quiet one.

Then there is Xavier from Mozambique. Any parent would be proud to call him son. He is well mannered, friendly and meets life with a smile. He is from one of the poorest countries on earth, but from a church of 5,000 plus, where the word of God is honored and faith is strong. Two weeks ago he was healed instantaneously in class. He had been suffering from fever, flu etc. He asked to give a testimony last week, with joy that is contagious he said, "God healed me immediately when we prayed in class that night"! Time and space will not permit to speak of their remaining 100 classmates. Each has a unique testimony of where God has brought them from and how He led them to this Bible School.

Please remember us in your prayers. We accept these students as sent by the Lord. There is a burden with that blessing as we seek to equip them for the work of the Lord. We are facing a real challenge making ends meet. There is always an enormous amount of printing, with machines breaking down, computers burning out, ever-increasing utilities and financial help for the African lecturers. We have been swimming upstream financially with the school for 17 years. God has promised and has always provided. We thank you again for your faithfulness and generous support.
