Philippians 1:6

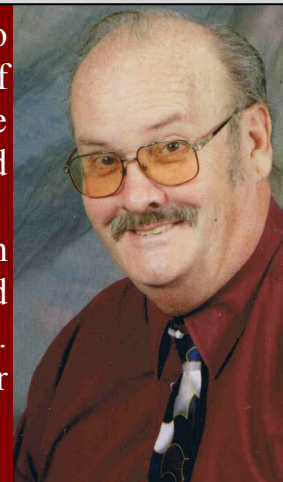
## SENIOR CITIZEN GET TOGETHER
