- He declared that he was at the Missions Training School to be equipped to lead this great fellowship of churches to fulfill its God given call to "preach the Gospel in all the world."

We experienced again what it means, "the blessings of the Lord makes rich and He adds no sorrow with them (Proverbs 10:22). God bless you again for counting the Gospel worthy to be declared.
