"Only One Name"

There are so many names that describe Jesus Christ as our savior. The picture on the front of the bulletin is one, He is *"the Rose of Sharon."* Another one is, *"He is the Lily of the Valley."* Isaiah called

him *"Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace..."* Throughout the Bible there are many names that were used to identify to Jesus. Everyone pointed to the fact that Jesus was the one that was the redeemer sent from heaven to redeem us from our sins.

How important is a name? What does a name mean? *Proverbs 22:1, "A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favor than silver and gold."* This scripture tells us it is better to have a good name than to be rich.
