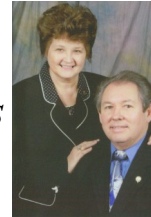

# *From the Pastor's Pen...*



A farmer, at the beginning of Spring plants his seed, that's really the last thought he has of the seed. He is too busy to sit around and think 'I wonder if that was good seed and I wonder when that seed will come up.' No, he doesn't think of the seed at all. Once the seed is in the ground, he puts his eyes and mind on the harvest. He begins to prepare for the harvest. How does he do that?

First of all he makes sure that his harvest to come has enough water and sunshine and nutrients by knowing the ground is prepared properly to receive his seed. Then he prepares to receive his harvest by making sure his barn is ready and all things are operational for the reaping.

As sowers - too often we keep our mind/hearts on the seed; I am talking about when we sow into the Kingdom of God by giving to ministries and other works of our money or time. We sow our seeds and then we continue to remind God of the seeds we have sown. We talk about things like, 'I sowed \$100 into that ministry and I haven't seen any results.' You see, we have been seed minded.

It's time to get harvest minded ~ get your mind off of the seed. One thing that will block your harvest is attitude. If you have sown seed to a ministry and then you are critical about what they are doing or not doing, you may block your harvest. Simply sow your seed where God says sow it and then let God grow it. To you, it is no longer seed anyway, it has now become harvest. Get your mind on the harvest, get your eyes on the harvest and pray to the Lord of the harvest to help you to bring it in.

***Golden Compass*** is a fantasy film based upon Northern Lights (titled The Golden Compass in the US), the first novel in Philip Pullman's trilogy His Dark Materials, slated for release on December 7, 2007 by New Line Cinema. The story tells of Lyra's adventure to the far north in search of her friend. An innocent book/movie it seems but, in October 2007, the Catholic League called for a boycott of the film, due to the source novel's anti-Christian themes.

New Line Cinema has commissioned screenwriter Hossein Amini to write a screenplay based on the second book in the trilogy, The Subtle Knife, potentially for release in late 2009; with the third book of the trilogy, The Amber Spyglass to follow.

Some schools are distributing books to children through the Scholastic Book Club.

Please pay special attention not only to what your kids watch on TV, in movie theaters, on the internet, and the music they listen to, but also **be alert regarding the books they read**. Two particular books are, Conversations with God and Conversations with God for Teens, written by Neale D. Walsch. They sound harmless enough by their titles alone. The author purports to answer various questions asked by kids using the "voice of God". However, the "answers" that he gives are not Bible-based and go against the very infallible word of God. For instance, when a girl asks the question "Why am I a lesbian?" His answer is that she was 'born that way' because of genetics (just as you were born right-handed, with brown eyes, etc.). Then he tells her to go out and "celebrate" her differences.

Another girl poses the question "I am living with my boyfriend. My parents say that I should marry him because I am living in sin. Should I marry him?"

His reply is, "Who are you sinning against? Not me, because you have done nothing wrong."

Another question asks about God's forgiveness of sin. His reply "I do not forgive anyone because there is nothing to forgive."
