We knew brother and sister Ledezma when we were little children and they were like our Uncle and Aunt to us and we played with their little girls who are now missionaries to Spain and Portugal and have many churches there in those countries also. Sister Ledezma would take care of me and my brother after school and she taught me how to make Mexican Tacos and Spanish rice and taught me how to read and sing in Spanish by singing out of the Spanish Hymn books. I learn just about 200 old songs that are not sung anymore today! Brother ledezma took Jonathan around to preach to the churches he planted all over the Northern part of Oaxaca and Jonathan had a wonderful time ministering to the peoples. Jonathan was able to take Bibles in Spanish to them and toys for the children and they were very delighted to see him! Jonathan wants to thank everyone who prayed for him and who sent him love offerings during his trip to Oaxaca and says he is very appreciative and grateful!!

Argentina Missionary Trip Report

Dear Friends Blessings to you; *Dear Gospel Truth Light House*

In the mean time my brother Jonathan was in Mexico, I took my mom and me to Argentina to meet up with my Sister Rebecca. She had been in Argentina a whole month preaching around revivals all over in all the churches in cities and in towns non-stop. When we arrived she was worn out and exhausted and looked at us and said it is your turn now, "I'm going to rest now." So my mom and me went to the first church and prayed for the sick and one lady that was so weak and feeble from having water on her lungs was brought in held up by her arms by two ladies to pray for her. When my mom prayed for her the Lord Jesus healed the lady and she was able to stand up without any assistance and said she was healed and began to preach like a fiery woman!! Another lady came in with a cane and had to sit down because the doctors messed up her knees in a knee surgery. After I prayed for her she said, "I feel healed" and said "I will not need to use my cane anymore" and she stood up and walked away rejoicing.

We then visited an orphanage and gave out toys to the children, and then we went to the parks where many young people were and found a child-evangelist who ministers to street children in the parks. Many of the street children live all week in the streets around the cities and towns and parks begging for food and money to survive on while the parents work all week and then they return to their shanty homes made out of card board or plywood on the weekends. Many of the children are refugee children from Herzegovina and from Bosnia... and the parents speak very little Spanish and victims of war and are very afraid of people.

For one to be able to go into the refuge vicinities one must be escorted by police or else the refugees will defend themselves with terror using metal poles to bash the windows in or rocks and stone. They are afraid of being hurt again. Many of the parents seeing that one that loves their children will come up and listen to the Bible stories and begin to weep and cry and will ask how to be saved, and so many refugee parents are being saved. Also there are many children from Bolivia and their parents also who come to the parks and are being saved. The day before we left there were 120 who showed up in one of the parks!! They are so happy to hear about Jesus and receive his

love. I promised the Argentinean Child Evangelist that works alone in the parks with only two helpers that I would try to find some help for them and bring them toys for Christmas this year, and they became so happy with laughter!!!

I hope it would be made possible so that many hearts of street children would be made happy. If you wish to do so let me know??

Also there was a Christian doctor I met who works among the tribal Indians of Argentina and Uruguay and Paraguay, and was begging for me to come back to them for they are so needy. Also the day before I was to leave they Uruguay people heard about us and were begging me to come to Uruguay but they did not tell me until the last day before I was to return home. I attempted to get on a ship, but the ship had already left, there were 300 pastors who said next time they will wait for me because no evangelist has ever been to Uruguay to bring revival and it is a country filled with atheist and witches and great darkness. I told them I would come back to them next time, and that God was going to break the darkness and bring revival to them and they greatly rejoiced.

In the meantime that night after trying to catch the ship, I did not know that one church in Argentina had a surprise party for my Birthday!! The church packed out to the seams and bus loads and truck loads of people arrived to the church hearing about me!! They had the biggest cake and had special Mariachi singers to sing to me!! I never expected to have such a special Birthday this year, it was so meaningful!!

Also the Ledezma girls in Spain and in Portugal have asked me to also go to their countries because they travel on trains back in front from town to town having revival meetings and wish to see me because they have not seen me since they were little girls. The sisters have about 20 churches they planted among each other between Spain and Portugal and they are younger than I am! I am so proud of them and I know Jesus is too.

My mom had a wonderful time in Argentina and wants to thank everyone for your prayers and for your love!! Please remember the children in Argentina and pray that they will have a wonderful Christmas this year so that they will know that Jesus loves them. Thank you for your love and prayers we appreciate you!!
