Please pray for Central America and the outreach to the victims of hurracion Stan. I tried to take a ship load of medications into El Salvador which was worse hit than New Orleans itself ..per not just one city but the whole country has been under water and children dying from water fungus.. As I tried to send the shipment of medicines there the other half of the government of El Salvador which is communist and have control over the customs and immigration...would not allow the ship to enter their country ..I was devastated!!! Half the El Salvador Government is Christians and the other half Communist and the communist are fighting the christians there now and are persecuting them. They have been rioting and protesting in the streets with their communist flags again the christians leaders who now are praying and fasting so God can help them against the persecution they are recieving ...so please pray for them. In the meantime I rerouted the ship to Guatemala and entered there with open arms and have been there this December for Christmas ..and will return again to oversee the medical outreaches to the Mayan Indians. Please pray for them ...most of the Indians villages have been devastated because of the floods and mountians fallen on whole entire villages ..One village was declared a cemetery because it is under 20 feet of mud and no one could be rescued!! From the Mayan Indians of each village 600 out of every 1000 have died!! I cry for them...and the Guatemalan Mayan Indians are very dear to my heart!!!! They call me their princess and think I'm the best thing that ever happend to thembut I tell them " Jesus is the Best thing for You!!!" The have the most beutiful smile and glow in their eyes that sparkle!!!! Please pray for me I return to them again this month in January to oversee the rest of the medical outreaches with them.. Pray that many souls will be touched and saved..

Also I want to thank everyone who blessed my mom and me when we went to Panama In September to see the Embera and the Chocoe Indians there this last summer in Darien near the borders of Colombia. The Chocoe Indians there painted themselves black with a black fruit so the bugs won;t bite them...but I was bitten all over with the Chocoe Indians bugs ...they are worse than chiggars and leave scars all over your body..its really terrible. I had so much medicines to do 3 medical outreaches there also from the medicines that I sent to them on a ship. This time it is 1500 lbs , so much medicine and so much work I had to leave before I could assist with the 3rd medical outreach to the Teribe Inidans up the river , but am so supriised at the native medical doctors that I left the medications withthey were able to reach many Teribe Indians for Jesus and have sent me the following report below!!!!

Thank you so much to each one of you who prayed for us during our recent medical mission. The entire undertaking was a great success. We're still tired, but we're recovering.

Some of the native doctors worked the entire week in the eye clinic, translating for the ophthalmologist and dispensing reading glasses. Others worked with the dentists. Many worked in both the pharmacy and triage, both translating and writing labels." Other jobs included putting out fires, entertaining the Teribe people and speaking to them about Jesus as they waited to see the doctors.

Most of the time, numbers don't tell very much of the story, but this time, I think they'll at least help you get an idea of the magnitude of last week's medical mission .

26: number of dugout canoe trips of people and cargo that went up the Teribe River.

1,013: number of medical patients seen by the doctors.

373: number of dental patients seen by the dentists.

300: number of patients seen in the eye clinic by the ophthalmologist and his assistants.

12,250: number of lunches cooked in the local school kitchen for the patients and medical personnel.

560, 280, 250: number of pounds of rice, chicken and beef it took to make all those lunches.

359: number of dinners cooked in our kitchen for the team.

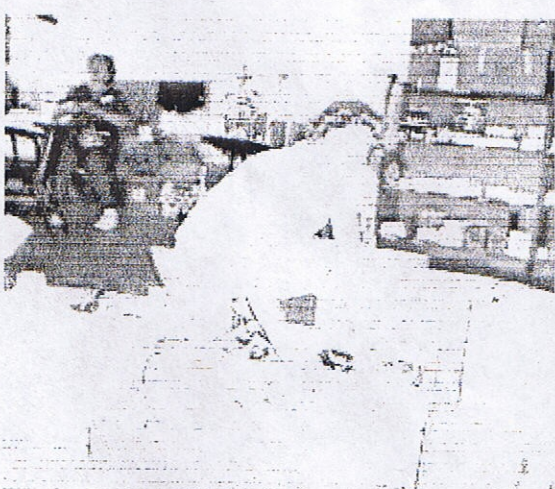
Changuinola
